LIMITS AND EXCLUSIONS

- Students may include not more than *two* of the following (HIST 1, 2 or 3).
- Seminars have limited enrollment, therefore, you must select a backup seminar.
- Students may not use more than 2 upper-class seminars (HIST 96) or more than 2 Independent Study Projects (HIST 97) in satisfying the requirements of the major.
- At least 5 courses must be taken in residence in Hanover, including the upper-level seminar.
- No major course may be taken NRO.
